Estimated Travelling Time: 20min.

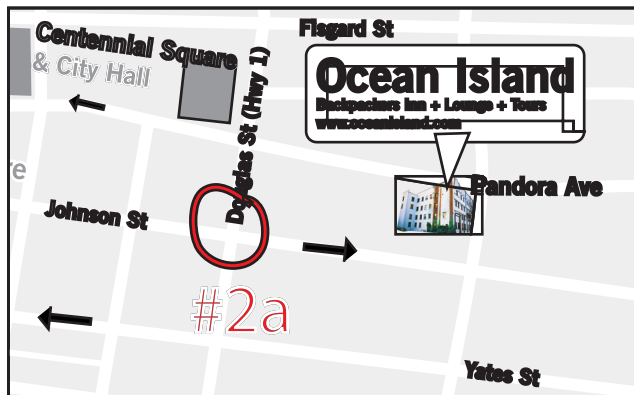
